### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For automatic dispensing please contact your Cleanslate representative for setup. **GREASE TRAPS:** For less than 20 cubic feet capacity, add 4-5 oz. of product daily by pouring in a sink or pipeline closest to the trap. This should be done at night or when the traps are used the least. After adding, flush down with a cup of lukewarm water. For grease traps larger than 20 cubic feet, add 8-10 oz. daily using the same procedure. **DRAIN AND PIPE LINES:** Use product a minimum of 2 times weekly to a maximum of 4 times depending on the usage of the building. Add 2 oz. of product per inch diameter, by pouring directly into drain pipe starting on the lowest floor and working up at a rate of one floor each day. Do not treat same floor twice. When the top floor is reached, continue from the top floor only.
